Reverse fold at about $\frac{3}{8}$, enlarge view



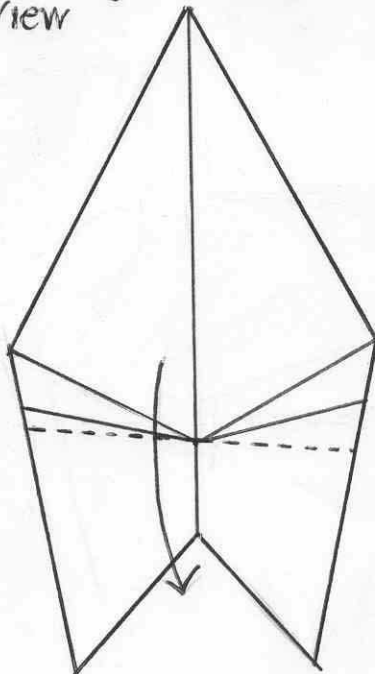
